ADVISORY

TO ALL OUR KABABAYANS:

The Embassy of the Philippines in Brasilia is reminding all Overseas Filipinos to check the validity of their passports and have them renewed if they have eight (8) months validity or less, taking into consideration the 6 - 8 weeks time frame a passport is delivered to their home address.

As a matter of policy, the Philippine Embassy discourages extensions of ePassports due to the fact that some foreign governments do not recognize the extension stamp, opting to stick to the validity date as stored in the chip of the ePassport. To avoid inconvenience to overseas Filipinos, the Philippine Embassy is reminding to check the validity of their passports.

In case of Overseas Filipinos returning to the Philippines for a short period of time, such as during their annual leaves, the Embassy is encouraging them to renew their passports prior to leaving for the Philippines. The Embassy is giving the option to Overseas Filipinos to renew them at the Embassy and have the passports picked up at Aseana, DFA, Philippines.
